We are looking for a proficient and passionate part-time Education Officer to advance the <u>Digital Labs: educators</u>.

Digital Labs: educators are mini hackathons for everyone involved in changing the educational sphere in Ukraine for the better. For participants, those are 9 days, 15 workshops with experts, 5 hours of personal mentoring sessions, and one project idea. For you: an opportunity to manage a challenging project, expand your professional network with experts from abroad, and back the educational reform in Ukraine.

House of Europe is an EU-funded programme fostering professional and creative exchange between Ukrainians and their colleagues in EU^{*1} countries and the UK. The programme focuses on different professional fields: culture and creative industries, education and youth work, social entrepreneurship, and media.

This encompasses 20+ separate programme lines enabling to keep working despite the war, to carry out personal projects, or to enrol in courses, conferences, and internships in the EU*. The programme funds cultural cooperation and literature translation between Ukraine and the EU*, along with the revitalisation of cultural infrastructure. House of Europe supports the safeguarding of Ukrainian cultural heritage and the development of

The programme is implemented by Goethe-Institut, the cultural institute of the Federal Republic of Germany. An Education Officer will work on programmes within House of Europe and will be part of the team of Goethe-Institut Ukraine.

- Designing high quality programme curriculum for Digital Labs and tailoring other capacity-building activities for education professionals

- Managing stakeholder relationships with speakers, partners and alumni of the programmes
- Managing open calls for participants and developing selection criteria
- Collecting statistical information and feedback from participants of the Digital Labs: educators to adjust the programme to the audience's needs
- Managing operational finances, financial planning, timeliness of payments, and reporting for the activities
- Subcontracting experts and partners in compliance with administrative rules: tenders and procurements, documentation of spendings
- Taking care of the related paperwork

What skills and qualifications do you need


- 2+ years of experience in project management
