We seek a proficient and passionate part-time officer to advance the Cultural Transformation Lab.

Cultural Transformation Lab is a series of practical education and networking events to support Ukrainian cultural managers, civil society, and cultural actors outside large cities and regional centres during the war.

Cultural Transformation Lab is a project by Goethe-Institut Ukraine in partnership with the Ministry of Culture and Information Policy of Ukraine and funded by the House of Europe.

# House of Europe

House of Europe is an EU-funded programme fostering professional and creative exchange between Ukrainians and their colleagues in EU\*1 countries and the UK. The programme focuses on different professional fields: culture and creative industries, education and youth work, social entrepreneurship, and media.

This encompasses 20+ separate programme lines enabling to keep working despite the war, to carry out personal projects, or to enrol in courses, conferences, and internships in the EU\*. The programme funds cultural

cooperation and literature translation between Ukraine and the EU\*, along with the revitalisation of cultural infrastructure. House of Europe supports the safeguarding of Ukrainian cultural heritage and the development of creative and educational start-ups. Various learning and matchmaking opportunities such as Digital Labs, workshops, discussions, conferences, and hackathons are offered.

House of Europe is implemented by Goethe-Institut. A Cultural Transformation Lab Officer will be part of the Goethe-Institut Ukraine team, working with funds of the House of Europe programme.

#### Goethe-Institut Ukraine

The Goethe-Institut is the cultural institute of the Federal Republic of Germany with a global presence. Goethe-Institut Ukraine is promoting German-Ukrainian cultural and educational dialogue since 30 years. In reaction to the full-scale Russian war of aggression against Ukraine, it has substantially supported its wide network of Ukrainian partners and actively contributed to the resilience of the Ukrainian cultural sector.

- Designing high-quality programmes for online workshops in close cooperation with the trainers of the Cultural Transformation Lab
- Reaching out to and collaborating with trainers, experts, organisations, and professional networks from Ukraine and the EU\* to design engaging programmes
- Managing relationships with trainers, the Ministry of Culture and Information Policy of Ukraine, and alumni of the programmes
- Managing open calls for participants and developing selection criteria
- Collecting statistical information and feedback from participants to adjust the programme to the audience's needs
- Managing operational finances, financial planning, timeliness of payments, and reporting for the activities

- Subcontracting experts and partners in compliance with administrative rules: tenders and procurements, documentation of spending, etc.
- Taking care of the related paperwork, including invoice processing and other financial tasks

- English and Ukrainian to C1 level
- University degree in cultural management, arts and humanities, or equivalent
- Experience and network in cultural sector
- Ability to successfully work in a team, while being self-motivated and illustrate initiative with regards to job responsibilities
- Self-reflection and acceptance of criticism
- Structured and result-oriented approach
- Ability to work under stress and with temporarily high workload
- Readiness to travel for business and work on weekends and in the evenings when needed
